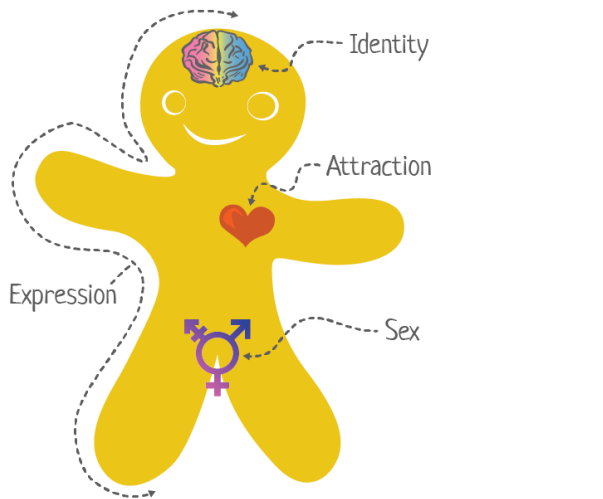

 Female Intersex Male

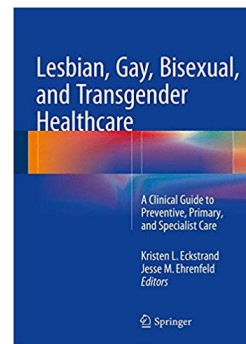
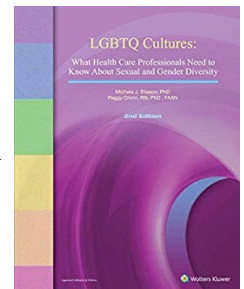
